<u>Political Activities of The Official Monster Raving Loony Party for the Year 2012</u> 2012 By-elections

We stood in three by-elections in 2012; Howling Laud Hope came seventh out of ten candidates at Bradford with 145 votes. Howling Laud polled 198 votes on 3rd March in Barnsley Central and a whopping 553 on the 5th May in Leicester South.

Review of Financial Activities

Our books are balanced and comfortably in the black. We have a small deficit this year of £148.15, but we saved in the good times and can now spend a little in the bad. The Loony Party has once again demonstrated that it is the antithesis of government and ergo the most suitable party to govern. The Loony Party is dismayed by the economic depression caused by profligate government spending combined with a failure to apply existing legislation to an anarchistic banking sector. "It is time for the Legislature to employ a retiring criminal judge as chief executive of the Financial Conduct Authority, hire a leading criminal barrister as the head of enforcement, and bring in some decent former fraud detectives, to prosecute criminality in the banking sector."
