#### 2011 By-elections

We stood in three by-elections in 2011; Nick 'The Flying Brick' Delves came seventh out of ten candidates at Oldham & Saddleworth with 145 votes. Alan 'Howlin Laud' Hope polled 198 votes on 3<sup>rd</sup> March in Barnsley Central and a whopping 553 on the 5<sup>th</sup> May in Leicester South.
