2011 By-elections

We stood in three by-elections in 2011; Nick 'The Flying Brick' Delves came seventh out of ten candidates at Oldham & Saddleworth with 145 votes. Alan 'Howlin Laud' Hope polled 198 votes on 3rd March in Barnsley Central and a whopping 553 on the 5th May in Leicester South.

Membership

Membership is still £9.99 a year; in 2011 the Loony Party had 128 paying members.
